1.0 Introduction -

Allscreens Nationwide Ltd, is committed to respecting the privacy of our customers and of visitors to this website. This policy sets out who we are, the kind of information we may collect and hold, and how it is used. 3.0 Data We collect:

Data we process about you includes:

- **Personal Data:** Such as your name, address, Gender, title, Insurance details, Address of where the work will be taking place etc.
- **Contact Data:** Such as your Email address, phone number, vehicle registration number etc
- **Financial Information:** Such as billing address, payment card details, bank details etc.
- **Technical Data:** Such as your IP address, login data, time zone settings, Approximate locations of device you are using, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform and other technology on the devices you use to access our website.
- **Company Data:** Such as names, Phone numbers and email addresses, Registered address etc.
- **Usage data:** Such as information on how you use our website and services.

4.0 How we collect this data -

- **Direct Contact:** You may give us your data via direct correspondence, this may be via email, post, phone, or else ways.
- **Cookies:** As you browse our website, your computer will provide small pieces of data which record your online activity. Our cookies are only used to store temporary data; any information held will not be held once you leave our site. If you do not wish to enable cookies, you can do so by referring to your device's settings.
- **Third Parties or publicly available data:** we may receive personal data about you from multiple third-party sources; these could include; Insurers, insurance brokers and vehicle leasing organisations, Companies house, Analytics, advertising networks, DVLA etc.

5.0 How we use your personal data:

We will only use your personal information in compliance with the data protection laws.

Set out below are some different examples of how we use your data.

- Performance of a contract with you or in readiness for such contract e.g., To provide you with a quotation and agree contract with you, to set up an account etc.
- To validate your insurance policy details
- Process outstanding payments.

9.0 Your Rights -

Under certain circumstances, by law you have the right to:

- Request erasure of your personal data.
- Object to processing of your personal data.
- Request the restriction of processing of your personal data.
- Request the transfer of your personal data to another party.

Depending on the circumstances and the nature of your request it may not be possible for us to do what you have asked, for example, where there is a statutory or contractual requirement for us to process your personal data and it would not be possible to fulfil our legal obligations if we were to stop.
